

# PHOTO WALLPAPER

SELF-ADHESIVE WALLPAPER

*-How to attach-*

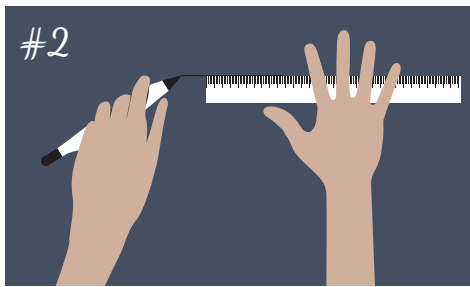


Unroll the wallpaper strips and lay them out in order. The strip numbers are printed at the bottom edge of each strip, alongside a small preview.

Now slowly peel the white, folded down backing paper away in a downwards motion. Press the wallpaper down bit by bit as you go.



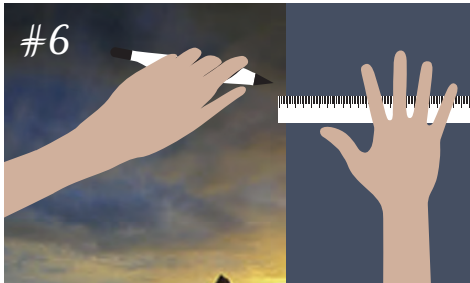
Measure the wall carefully and accurately, and mark where you want to place the first strip. If you want to cover the entire wall using the wallpaper, skip this step and start at the left-hand corner.



Carefully pull one corner of the white backing paper away at the top of the first strip. Fold the backing paper down to reveal a small section of the adhesive surface.



Place the wallpaper strip sticky side first onto the wall along the guide line or where the wall meets the ceiling. Press the wallpaper firmly onto the wall at the top edge.



Carefully mark an overlap area about 3 mm from the edge of the wallpaper. To improve accuracy you should make several marks at regular intervals.



7 Now stick the next strip on. Place it using the guide marks you made in step 6. Repeat steps 6 and 7 until you have attached all the strips.



When you have attached all the wallpaper strips, go over them once more with a felt squeegee or a soft cloth to fix them firmly in place. If necessary, the strips can now be individually cut to size using a cutting knife. Done!
